Healthy Lunches

Back to School Lunchbox Tips

Sandwiches: cut sandwiches in to quarters or sandwich soldiers; for the little ones, trial cookie cutters; to introduce wholemeal breads try zebra sandwiches - one layer white bread the other wholegrain.

Sparkling Interest: get your kids involved - shopping, preparing, baking and packing lunchbox foods; give foods fun names - think rainbow wraps, super-hero salad, dinosaur broccoli trees, power ranger pitas, princess pillows (ravioli) or dinosaur eggs (gnocchi)

Early Preparation: bake & freeze mini muffins, pikelets, frittatas, use bread in muffin tins rather than pastry for mini quiches, or make simple sandwiches & freeze them for future use (they will defrost in lunchbox).

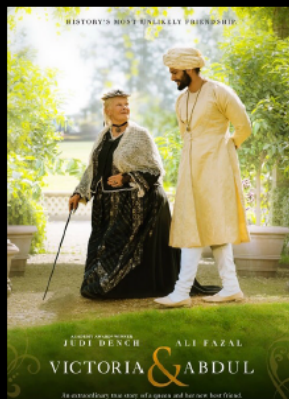
