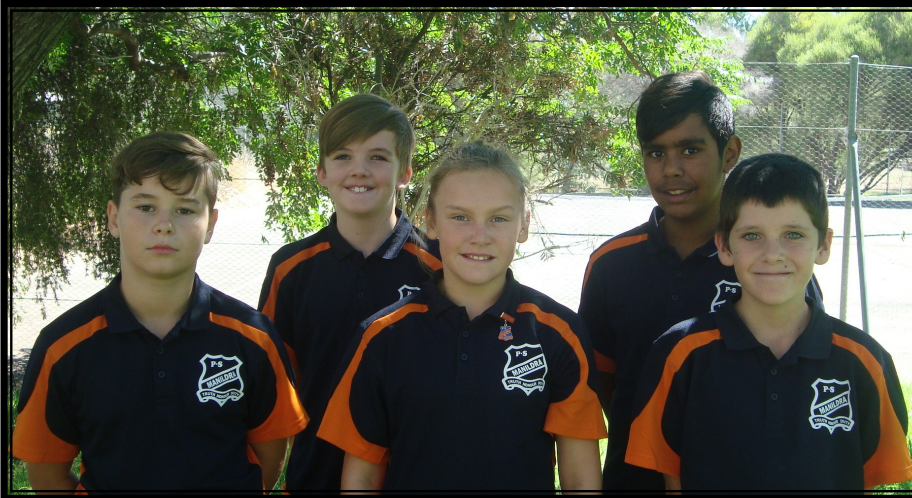
PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

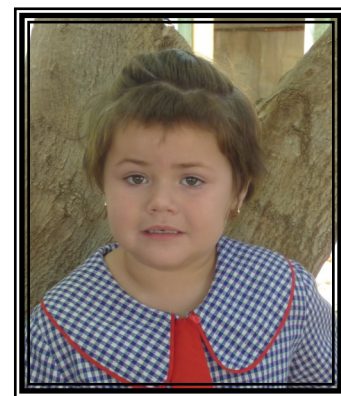

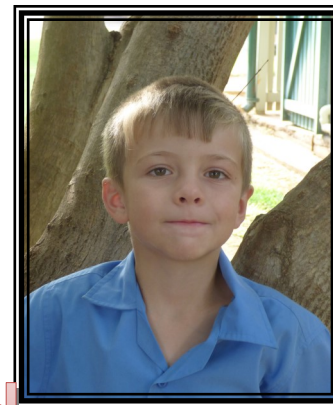

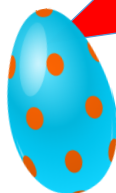
