### **Absences**

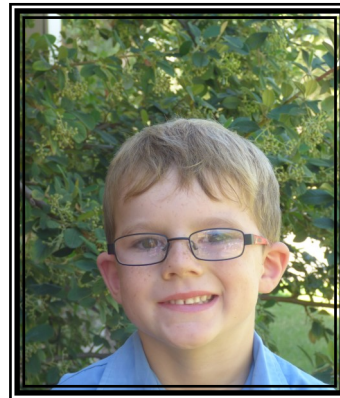

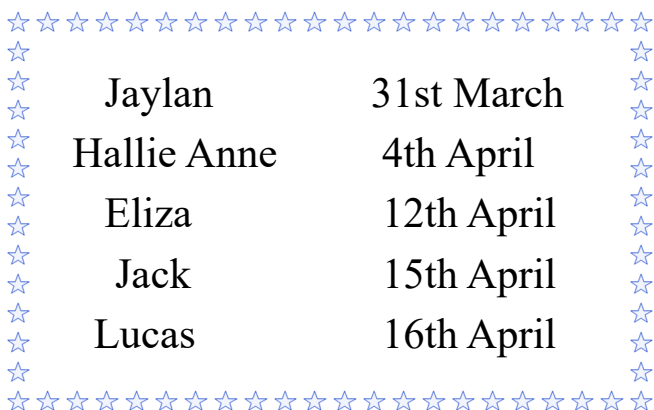
