Our staff development during this term focuses on:

- ♦ Seven Steps to Successful Writing, a program that gives students a variety of strategies to improve their Narrative and Persuasive texts. The students particularly enjoy "Sizzling Starts."
- ♦ The staff have also completed a 6 week training course on Super 6 Comprehension looking at a variety of strategies to improve the meaning and understanding of the texts our students are reading.
- ♦ Manildra staff are also being trained in becoming a Visible Learning School which gathers evidence on what practices work best to support our student's learning needs.

This year our school has been chosen to have the External Validation Process completed. I will be very busy putting this together with the panel visiting will be at Manildra during August.

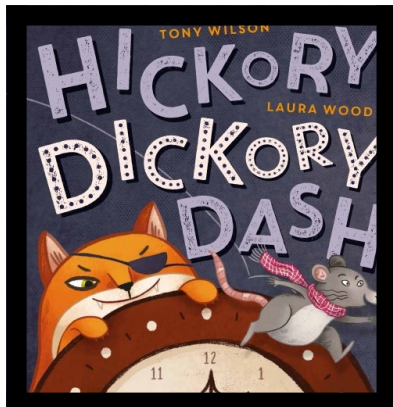
3 Way Conference

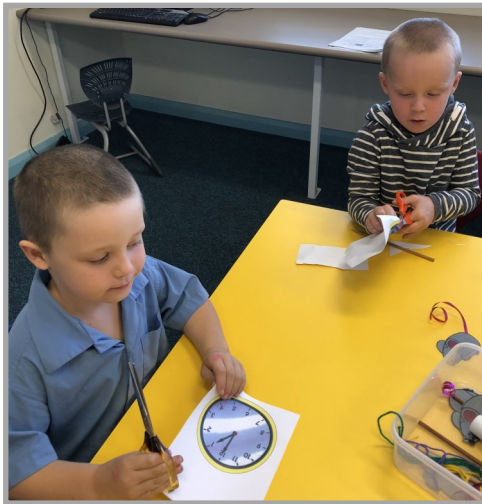
