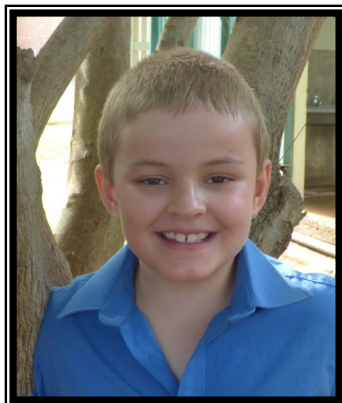
The 2 adjudicators, gave us great feedback and awarded us the win!
