P & C run this voluntarily and are looking for additional community members to spend 1 hour over lunch, one Monday per term to assist with putting lunches together.

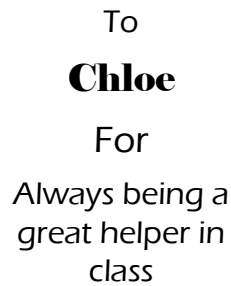
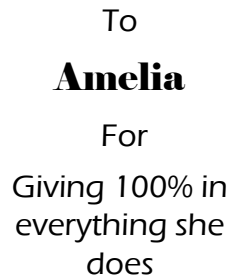
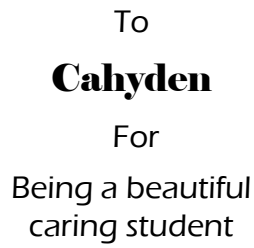
If you are a grandparent or someone who would enjoy giving time to our children it would be appreciated.

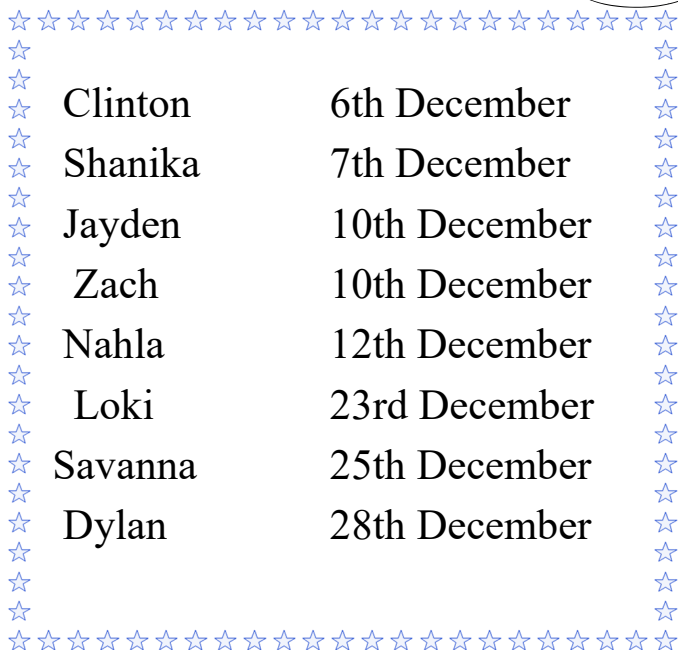
